## **Updated notice of ongoing proceedings Disputes between Wintipak AG and New JF/Greatview Group**

Dear Valued Customer,

Wintipak AG issues this notice to update interested parties regarding the proceedings between Wintipak AG and Greatview Holdings Limited ("Greatview Holdings").

Reference is made to the notice published on Wintipak AG's website on 25 March 2026 entitled "Notice of ongoing proceedings" ("March Notice").

### **Legal proceedings announced by Greatview Holdings' parent company**

Greatview Holdings is a 100% owned subsidiary of Greatview Aseptic Packaging Company Limited (HKEX: 00468) ("GAPCL").

On 17 August 2026, GAPCL issued an announcement headed "Quarterly Update on the Status of Resumption and Continued Suspension of Trading" ("August Update"). The August Update gave notice of various legal proceedings commenced by GAPCL and its subsidiaries, including those against Wintipak AG. The August Update did not mention, among other matters, the proceedings commenced by Wintipak AG against Greatview Holdings.

### **Emergency Award and Enforcement Order obtained by Wintipak AG against Greatview Holdings**

As stated in Wintipak AG's March Notice, in December 2025, Wintipak AG filed an application to the Hong Kong High Court and obtained an Order to enforce an Emergency Arbitration Award ("Emergency Award") made against Greatview Holdings on 21 November 2025 (and corrected on 16 December 2025) in an arbitration administered by the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre ("HKIAC"). The High Court of Hong Kong made an order dated 30 December 2025 enforcing the relief granted in the Emergency Award ("Enforcement Order"). Wintipak has evidence that Greatview Holdings has not complied with the Emergency Award or Enforcement Order.

On 31 August 2026, an arbitral tribunal constituted under the HKIAC Rules issued its decision dismissing Greatview Holdings' application to discharge the Emergency Award. The arbitral tribunal rejected the application and upheld the Emergency Award in its entirety.

As a result, the Emergency Award was binding and fully effective against Greatview Holdings from the date of issue of the Emergency Award and remains binding.

The Enforcement Order of Hong Kong Court in the same terms of the Emergency Award remains in force and continues to be binding on Greatview Holdings.

The Emergency Award and the Enforcement Order require Greatview Holdings to comply, and to procure its affiliates to comply, with the Framework Agreement entered into between Wintipak AG and Greatview Holdings.



In particular, Greatview Holdings is required to cease and refrain from acts in breach of certain provisions of the Framework Agreement, including, but not limited to:

- (i) contacting Wintipak AG's customers for service or business,
- (ii) inviting Wintipak AG's customers to place orders with Greatview Holdings or its affiliates for services or business which fall within the scope of the Framework Agreement; and/or
- (iii) entering into contracts or arrangements for delivery to Wintipak AG's customers of products coerced by the Framework Agreement.

Greatview Holdings is also required to procure its affiliates (which include Shandong NewJF Technology Packaging Co., Ltd. (山东新巨丰科技包装股份有限公司) (301296.SZ) and its subsidiaries) to comply with the Framework Agreement including points (i), (ii) and (iii) above.

Wintipak AG remains committed to protecting its rights and business interests and will continue to take all appropriate steps to enforce its rights pursuant to the Emergency Award and the Enforcement Order. In particular, Wintipak AG remains committed to supporting its customers in returning to and remaining with Wintipak AG as a consequence of Greatview Holdings' wrongful efforts to draw them away. Wintipak AG sincerely regrets any disruption to its customers' business caused by Greatview Holdings' wrongful actions. All customers are encouraged to contact Wintipak AG with any questions they may have.
