Notice of ongoing proceedings Disputes between Wintipak AG and New JF/Greatview Group

Wintipak AG issues this notice to inform interested parties of the existence of proceedings that are ongoing between Wintipak AG and Greatview Holdings Ltd ("Greatview Holdings").

Legal proceedings already announced

Greatview Holdings is a 100% owned subsidiary of Greatview Aseptic Packaging Company Limited (HKEX: 00468) ("GAPCL").

On 12 February 2026 GAPCL issued an announcement headed Quarterly Update on the Status of Resumption of Trading and Continued Suspension of Trading ("Update"). The Update gave notice of two actions in the High Court of Hong Kong against related parties of Wintipak AG and an arbitration filed with the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre ("HKIAC") by Greatview Aseptic Packaging (Shandong) Co., Ltd. (紛美包裝 (山東) 有限公司) ("Greatview Shandong"), an indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of the GAPCL. Greatview Shandong is 100% owned by Greatview Holdings.

Shandong NewJF Technology Packaging Co., Ltd. (山东新巨丰科技包装股份有限公司) (301296) ("NewJF") issued a notice on 23 January 2026 also giving notice of the above arbitration and one set of legal proceedings.

On 19 March 2026, GAPCL and NewJF announced three other arbitrations against Wintipak AG and one of its subsidiaries had been filed with the Shanghai International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission ("SHIAC").


Arbitration commenced by Wintipak

The above announcements and notices did not mention that prior to the commencement of the HKIAC arbitration filed by Greatview Shandong, Wintipak AG had brought proceedings against Greatview Holdings.

In December 2025, Wintipak AG filed an application to the Hong Kong High Court and obtained an Order to enforce an Emergency Arbitration Award ("Emergency Award") made against Greatview Holdings Limited on 21 November 2025 (and corrected on 16 December 2025). The Emergency Award was made under the auspices of the HKIAC. It orders Greatview Holdings Limited to comply, and to procure its affiliates to comply, with a Framework Agreement between Wintipak AG and Greatview Holdings Ltd and to stop and refrain from actions in breach of certain sections of the Framework Agreement including but not limited to (i) contacting Wintipak's customers for service or business or (ii) inviting Wintipak's customers to place orders with the Defendant or its affiliates for services or business which fall within the scope of the Framework Agreement.

Greatview Holdings Limited has applied to set aside the Order made by the High Court of Hong Kong. A one day hearing has been set for 19 May 2026 in the High Court of Hong Kong.
